



**Directions: View at 20'** The row where you still have the ability to see separate lines and distinguish corners without straining is the distance a person without vision problems can view at 20'. 3 lines and 2 spaces is equal to the block letters of the literate chart. The mid point of the star spokes are approximately the width of the lines and spaces.

**40' = 3.56mm Lines & Spaces**

**30' = 2.64mm Lines & Spaces**

**25' = 2.22mm Lines & Spaces**

**20' = 1.78mm Lines & Spaces = 1 minute of arc, 1/60th°**

**15' = 1.33mm Lines & Spaces**

**13' = 1.16mm Lines & Spaces**

**10' = 0.86mm Lines & Spaces**
